

THE PETITIONERS ABOVENAMED STATED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The 1st Petitioner then a Spinster(nee MISS MONALI NARESH PANCHAL) was married to the 2nd Petitioner then a bachelor at punvel on 3rd May 2007 according to the Hindu Vedic rites. Hereto annexed and marked Exhibit - "A" is the MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE. Both the Petitioners are of Indian Domicile and both are Hindus.



- 2. There is no issue out of the said marriage.
- Immediately after the marriage the 1^{rt} Petitioner and the 2rd
 Petitioner co-habitude and resided at Panvel for a week, within
 the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.
- 4. After week of the said marriage, serious differences arose between the Petitioners and because of that there were regular arguments between them which ultimately culminated into quarrels. There came a time when it became impossible for the Petitioners to live together under the same roof. Inspite of that the Petitioners made their best efforts to work out their differences, but to no avail as temperamentally they were totally different.
- In or about June, 2007 because of serious differences, the Petitioners stopped having any marital relations with each other and started residing separately at the address stated in the title till.
- 6. The Petitioners say and submit that in the circumstances aforesaid, the Petitioners have been living separately for a period of more than five years before filing of this petition. Even thereafter the Petitioners made their beat efforts to work out their differences with the interventions of friends and family members but to no avail.
- 7. The Petitioners state that because of the serious differences which arose between them they realized that they were totally incompatible and could not lead a harmonious life and they found it impossible to adjust with each other and have mutually agreed to dissolve the said marriage by filing this Petition in this Hon'ble Court.
- 8. The 1st Petitioner does not claim any amount from the 2nd Petitioner by way of alimony. Both the Petitioners are working for gain and therefore do not claim any alimony from each other.
- 9. The Petitioners say and submit that as regards alimony, distributions of personal belongings etc., the Pentioners have arrived at consent Terms, a copy of which is hereto annexed and marked as Exhibit "B".
- 7. Both the Pertitioners agree that they show not have any claim or allegation against each other now or under eny changed circumstances in future.

- 10. There is no collusion or connivance between the Petitioners regarding the subject matter of the Petition. The Petitioners say that they have made their best efforts to live together and to live a normal happy life but they have failed in their endeavors.
- 11. The Petitioners therefore submit that they have become entitled to a decree of divorce under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. The Petitioners submit that there are no legal grounds why the relief claimed for should not be granted.
- There is no fraud, force or undue influence in presenting this Petition.
- 13. There is no unnecessary or improper delay in filing this Petition.
- 14. No other proceedings with respect to the subject matter of this Petition between the Petitioners have been filed in this Hon'ble Court or in any other court in India.
- 15. The said Petitioners have last resided at panvel, and therefore this Hon'ble Court has jurisdiction to entertain and try this Petition.
- 16. The Petitioners will refer to and rely upon the documents a list whereof is hereto annexed.
- 17. Fixed Court-fees of Rs.100/- has been paid on this Petition.
- 18. The Petitioners therefore pray:

They further states that because of the serious differences which


arose between them they realized that they were totally
